



Fill a tray with shaving foam. Your child then can use a finger to practise forming letters in the foam.



Fill a sandwich bag with paint and seal. Your child can then use a cotton bud to practise forming the letters on the bag.



Fill a tray with glitter, salt or sand. Your child can then use a finger or a dry paintbrush to practise forming the letters in the tray.



Outside your child can use a paintbrush dipped in water to practise forming letters on the ground. If they need extra support you could draw the letter for them first in



Drawing a letter for your child to trace over the top in a different colour each time.
