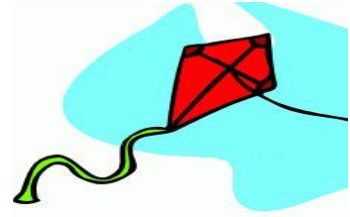


That's What I Like
