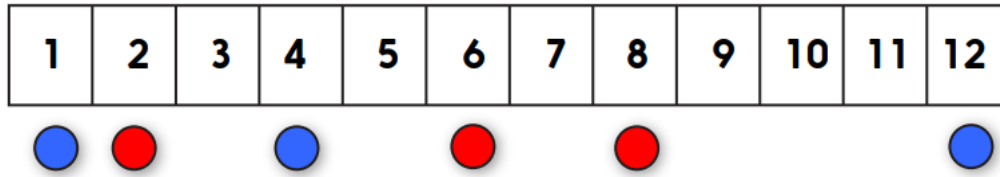


Addition Towers



You will need:

- 2 players
- 0-10 Number track
- 6 coloured counters (2 different colours)
- 2 dice
- Small cubes

How to play:

1. First, both players choose 3 different numbers to put their counters below.
2. Now, take it in turns to roll 2 dice and work out the total.
For example, if you roll a 5 and a 2, the total would be 7.
3. If the total is one of your numbers, you can put a cube on it.
4. Carry on playing until one person has a tower of three cubes on one of their numbers. That person is the winner!
5. Play again!

Challenge Questions:

- Which is the worst number to choose? Why?
- Which are really good numbers to choose? Why?
- Do the bigger numbers come up more often or not?
