

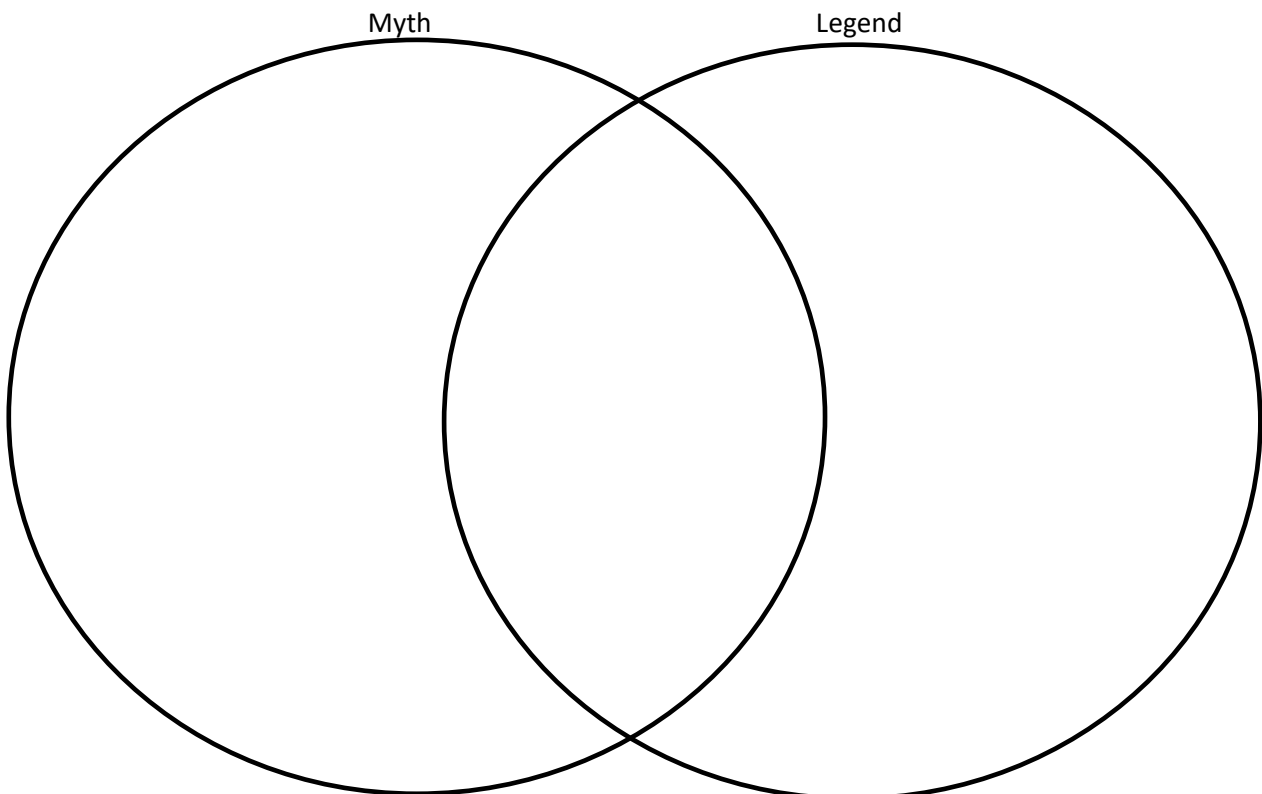
Comparing Myths and Legends
