## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

### **NEPAL EARTHQUAKE**

Your work will be marked out of 25, which will be multiplied to give you a percentage mark out of 100.

#### **Task 1:**

However your report is to be presented, you will need to write a script. Think about the important facts you need to include, as well as how you will keep your audience interested. You may want to plan every sentence or you may want to just jot down the main points to talk about.

There are 10 marks for the information you include, 10 marks for the quality of your writing/script and 5 marks for the quality of your presentation (for example, images on the storyboard, confidence on camera, and so on).
