Task 4: Justification	0-3 marks Not completed or 1-2 basic sentences, e.g. 'People need houses.'	5-6 marks 2-3 sentences with some relevance to task, e.g. 'School for the children.'	7-9 marks 4+ sentences explaining housing and services with relevance to task, e.g. 'More houses as people want their own gardens.'	10-12 marks 4+ detailed sentences with some relevance to task, e.g. 'School for the children'. Housing and services explained clearly.	13-15 marks 4+ detailed sentences relevance to task, e.g. 'School for the children.' Evidence consumer considered.	/15
